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Learning Objectives

- Describe how health coaching skills assist patients in gaining the knowledge, skills, and confidence to become informed, active partners in their care
- Collaborate with patients to Set the Agenda for a visit
- Apply Ask-Tell-Ask to assess and build on a patient's knowledge and motivation
- Apply a client-centered approach to reinforce new information and steps to complete an action
- Explain common reasons patients do not take their medications and strategies for addressing patient concerns
- Apply medication reconciliation with the patient
- Describe a four-question sequence to assess patient knowledge of their prescribed medications
